
Since the problem of environmental degradation is global, a concerted efforts need to be launched to infuse "environment-conscience" among all and sundry before it gets too late to mend the matters

## ENERGY CONSERVATION

- Awareness is created in institute to save energy by displaying poster and article regularly

- Electricals devices are switched off when not in use
- Computer CRT monitors are replaced by LCD monitors to save energy.
- Students are directed to use staircase for minimum three floors to minimize the energy consumption by the use of lift
- Students are encouraged to work on projects leading to energy conservation.

# USE OF RENEWABLE ENERGY

- Institute is conscious about the use of renewable energy and constantly creates the awareness and motivates research and implementation in this area
- Faculty and students are encouraged to work on projects on renewable energy
- Institute has proposed and is working on solar roof top as a renewable source of energy


